## Meals

The district will be providing bag lunch and bag breakfast meals for students during the school closure. Breakfast and lunch will be distributed for students using a "drive through" approach from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Meal pick up locations include: Pleasantville Elementary, Hydetown Elementary and Titusville Middle School.

Families must have their students with them in the vehicle, in order to follow state guidelines. Each student receiving a lunch and breakfast must be physically present in the car. Any child in the school district, age 18 or younger is eligible even if they do not attend any of our schools.

We continue to follow guidance from the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE), The Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA DOH) and the Center for Disease Control (CDC) during this national health emergency.
