Titusville Area School District Chromebook Protection Plan

A protection plan for the Chromebook is available through Titusville Area School District. The protection plan covers school issued Chromebooks in the event of theft, damage by fire or other accidental damage. In the event of theft or damage by fire, a police or fire report must be submitted to the district office within three (3) business days of the event. The protection plan covers one Chromebook per student per school year.

The cost of the protection plan is \$25 per student or \$35 per family. Enrolling in the family protection plan will cover all district students living in the same household. Checks must be made payable to Titusville Area School District. Purchasing the protection plan is not required, but students are responsible for all repair/replacement costs if their Chromebooks are not covered.

The protection plan will not cover intentional damage nor does it cover the outright loss of the device or its parts (e.g. – power adapter). Malicious damage (defined as deliberate, willful destruction) is not covered under any circumstance. If any damage is determined to be malicious, parents/guardians will be responsible to pay any repair/replacement costs. Students may be provided a loaner device for use in school, but will not be permitted to take it home.

Depending on the damage and whether or not the damage was accidental or due to a malfunction or maintenance issue, the Titusville Area School District protection plan would be used to determine the cost of the repairs.

It is the responsibility of each student to care for his/her Chromebook and to maintain it as well as possible. Defacing the Chromebooks will result in repair costs to replace whatever parts of the Chromebook are defaced. In the case of intentional damage and/or neglect, the student will pay the full repair or replacement cost of the device.

Examples of defacing/intentional damage include but are not limited to:

- Writing on the case, front, back, bottom or top
- Removing keys from the keyboard
- Writing on keys
- Breaking the hinge covers or screen

- Breaking the corners of the case through harsh treatment of the Chromebook
- Breaking or damage to the screen

No student or person should dismantle the Chromebook or attempt to perform repairs of any kind to the Chromebook. If the case is opened the Chromebook will be replaced at the parents' cost.

Please keep in mind that Chromebooks may be issued to another student when your child is done with it.

Approximate repair/replacement costs (subject to change):

- Screen \$150
- System board \$120
- Keyboard \$60
- Outer Top Case \$50
- Outer Bottom Case \$50
- Power Adapter \$40
- Battery \$40
- Camera \$35
- Touchpad \$30
- Hinges \$13
- Wireless Card \$10
