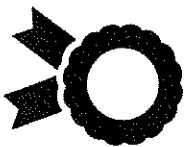

Congratulations to the following grade level spelling bee winners:

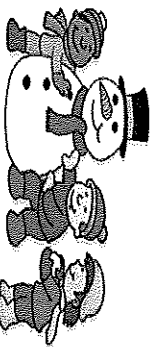
