### Parent/Teacher Conferences (Nov. 9th and 10th)

NOTES FROM THE NURSE

### THE BASICS.....

Help your student get the basics at home so they do well at school:
-SLEEP- school aged kids should get between 9-12 hours of sleep a night. Start a nightly routine to get to bed at a reasonable time.
-NUTRITION- eating breakfast is linked to improved concentration and increased energy. Help your student get to school early to get breakfast at school.

### **EXAMS**

The Department of Health requires all students in K5 to have physical and dental exam and students in grade 3 to have dental exams. Please turn these in if you haven't already.

### STAY HOME IF.....

Please keep your child home with fever >100.4, vomiting or diarrhea in last 24 hours, severe earache, or undiagnosed rash.

#### REMINDER

Please remember to have an extra set of clothes in your student's backpack.

### FALL BACK...

Don't forget to turn your clocks back November 5th and change the batteries in your smoke alarms!
