### Parent/Teacher Conferences (Nov. 7th and 8th)

Parent teacher conferences will be held on November 7<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon and in the morning of November 8<sup>th</sup>. You have received a letter home from your child's teacher requesting a conference on one of these days. If you did not receive a letter and would like to participate in a conference with the teacher, you may write a note requesting a conference or call to set up a time to discuss your child's progress. Students will be dismissed three hours early on November 7<sup>th</sup> with no afternoon PreK classes. There will be NO SCHOOL on November 8<sup>th</sup> for students.

#### **HEALTH ROOM HAPPENINGS**

- **O THE BASICS:** 
  - SLEEP- school aged kids should get between 9-12 hours of sleep a night. Start a nightly routine to help them get to bed at a reasonable time.
  - NUTRITION eating breakfast is linked to improved concentration and increased energy. Get your student to school early to get breakfast at school or make breakfast together at home.
- © **EXAMS**: The Department of Health requires all students in Kindergarten to have physical and dental exams. Please turn these in if you haven't already.
- © **STAY HOME IF**: Your student has a fever over 100.4 and keep them home until fever free for 24 hours without medication.
- © **CLOTHES**: <u>Please</u> keep an extra set of clothes in your student's backpack. Accidents happen a lot.
