#### **HEALTH ROOM HAPPENINGS: FALL IS IN THE AIR!**

- The Mobile Dentist will be at the ECLC on October 28th. If you want your student to be seen, please return the permission slip ASAP. If you are interested in the program, please call the school and ask to speak to the nurse.
- Flu season will be here before we know it so please speak to your child's doctor about flu shots. Influenza can be dangerous for

children. It is important to discuss this with your health care provider.

- The nurses are busy administering vision, hearing, and growth screenings for all of our students. This is a requirement by Pennsylvania school code. If your student does not pass a screening, you will be notified. If you have any questions about the screenings, please contact the nurse.
- Accidents happen! A lot. Especially with our little ones. Please keep an extra set of clothes in your student's backpack for accidents or spills. We have a limited supply in the health office so this really helps us out.

#### **MUSIC NOTES - Miss H**

The students have been doing awesome in the music room! We have already learned so many things! The Kindergarten students have been learning about fast and slow, steady beat, and many other musical ideas. They have been able to play egg shakers, rhythm sticks, bells, and sound shapes. #### **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

Please read this carefully and call if you have any questions.

A parent excuse is accepted for any day absent up to the total of ten (10). A doctor's excuse will be accepted for any absence during the year and is counted in the first ten (10) parental excuse days. Following the accumulation of ten (10) parent excuses, parents will receive a written notice/letter advising them of the accumulation of ten days absences, and that the district will require a doctor's



excuse for each day's absence from the time of the notice until the end of the year. <u>Please note:</u> Vacation days <u>are</u> counted in the ten parental excuses. Finally, if the school does not receive an excuse within three days of an absence, the absence will be recorded as an unlawful. Parents are allowed up to three (3) unlawful absences. Letters will be sent to keep you posted of any unlawful days.

#### **SCHOOL HOURS**

The building opens for students at 7:30 a.m. To be to school on time, students should be in their classrooms by 8:15 a.m. or 12:15 p.m. for PM Prekindergarten students. Students are dismissed at 2:50 p.m. for walkers/parent pick-up for Kindergarten and 2:45 pm for Prekindergarten.
