On August 10, 2022, the Board of School Directors met in Executive Session to consider, discuss and complete the 2021-2022 evaluation of the District's superintendent, Stephanie Keebler. The Board evaluated Mrs. Keebler on six performance standards: Student Growth and Achievement; Organizational Leadership; District Operations and Financial Management; Communication and Community Relations; Human Resource Management; and Professionalism. The evaluation included the following four potential ratings, in order of least favorable to most favorable: Failing; Needs Improvement; Proficient; and Distinguished. Stephanie Keebler received no ratings from any board member at Failing or Needs Improvement in any performance standards. Mrs. Keebler scored at or between Proficient and Distinguished in all performance standards, including three standards at which she scored unanimously at Proficient and three standards at which she scored unanimously at Distinguished.
